Veterinary Technician Position

All of our team members are regularly exposed to CE, both in-house and out of house. This year alone, more than 6 of our team members were sent to various conferences around the country. As part of the Partnership for Success with Pfizer, we occasionally have paid speaking positions available to our staff members.

Our technicians are expected to have a very thorough understanding of veterinary medicine, since they participate so heavily in our client education. In fact, all appointments are first seen by technicians so that they can take a thorough medical history on the patient, access its oral health, discuss the patient's diet and weight and do a risk assessment for non-core vaccines and wellness bloods. Our criteria for hiring an applicant include technical skill, but also give heavy weight to verbal and communication skills.
